Tree purchase is **cost-shared**, with the applicant paying 50% of the wholesale nursery selling price plus taxes in 2010. Bare root stock is approximately half the price of containerized stock. Typically, a discounted approximate price for 3-5 ft (100-150cms) bare root saplings is about \$6-8 per tree and thus containerized stock of similar height is about \$10-15 per tree. As well, larger trees may be available in a range of discounted prices.
