

# Non-native Maples

## Norway Maple

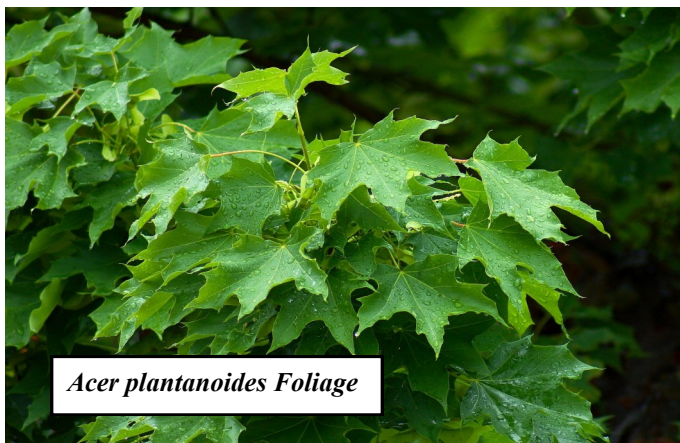
is a European tree (*Acer plantanoides*) with leaves that look similar to our native sugar maple.

The leaves are larger (10-18 cm), have 5-7 lobes with serrated margins and sharp-pointed tips. The upper surfaces are dark green, undersides lustrous.

A milky juice exudes from the leaf petiole when cut whereas that of a sugar maple is clear.

Norway maple is very tolerant of the urban environment and adapts to most soil conditions.

Fall colours range from yellows to brown.
